Nevada City tree guide



The new, free, Nevada City self-guiding walking Tree Tour is now available as a brochure. Pick up your copy at BriarPatch, around town, or at the Nevada City Chamber of Commerce. You can take the walk, passing through downtown Nevada City in one- or two-hour sections.

Ellen Solomon, BriarPatch member and volunteer with the Friends of Trees of Nevada County, originated the guide with funding from California ReLeaf and the Nevada City Chamber of Commerce, and the sponsorship of the Nevada County Land Trust, the California Native Plant Society, and others.
